## **How to Register:**

Spring: January 6, 2020: through your guidance counselor

Summer: May 11-15, 2020: through your guidance counselor

**Payments:** Once student has enrolled with their Guidance Counselor, payments can be made in the form of **Cash and money orders and will only be accepted at the Superior Junior/Senior High School Office** located at 100 W. Panther Drive, Monday-Friday 7:30a.m to 4:30p.m. Students will not be enrolled until amount is paid in full.

**Fees:** Full credit class: \$150.00  
½ credit class: \$75.00

**\*Financial Assistance**  
**(scholarships, payment plans, etc.) not available.**

**Format:** Superior Junior/Senior High School uses SchoolsPLP which is an online course credit recovery program. Please direct any and all inquiries about the program to the High School Counselor.

**Class lists:** These will be provided by High School Counselor.

**Refund Policy:** A refund will be given if the high school counselor or office is notified **prior to the first day** of each session. **No refunds will be given after first day of class.**

**Attendance Policy:** Students must be **present and on time every day.** Parents should call the attendance office (520-689-3000 ext. 3101) if a student will be late or absent from class. A student who misses more than two days (8 hours, including tardies) of their session will not receive credit for the course. Students, who are enrolled in a one-half credit course, will lose credit after missing more than one day (4 hours).

**Tardies:** Students are expected to be on time to class. Tardies include being late back from break periods. Teachers maintain attendance records of all tardies and will not excuse students for being late. All tardies will be calculated in 30 minute increments. All times will be rounded up for the recording of absences (i.e., 1 minute = 30 minutes, 31 minutes = 1 hour).

The firm absentee/tardy policy is in place due to the amount of study that is involved to successfully complete a spring or summer session. In one day, a student is completing an amount of work equal to one week of study during the regular school year. There are no “excused” absences. Please discuss the attendance policy with your student to be sure they are aware of the importance of attendance to earn for the course.

**Discipline:** Spring/Summer Session is an educational opportunity supported by tuition. Students who create disruptions during learning time will be suspended for inappropriate behavior. A parent conference will be held to determine if the student should continue in the program.
